CANNOT BE SHAKEN

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that <u>cannot be</u> <u>shaken</u>....(Heb. 12:28). A kingdom cannot be shaken when those in the kingdom cannot be shaken. Since we are made new creations (2 Cor. 5:17), made the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus (2 Cor. 5:21) through the work of God by grace through faith in the blood of Jesus and faith in Jesus' resurrection, our deepest inmost being cannot be shaken or jolted by our nonwillful mistakes or sins.

Our relationship with God cannot be shaken by our nonwillful sins or mistakes because of the blood sacrifice of Christ for us (Heb. 10:26) remains. When we nonwillfully sin or make a mistake, we repent of it, confess it, put it under the blood, correct as much as possible, then go on serving the living God (Heb. 9:14), living for righteousness (1 Pet. 2:24), receiving no fruit choking condemnation (Rom. 8:1) from self, others, or the devil, and not living tentatively by living not to make a mistake or sin. Nothing can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus (Rom. 8:37-39).
