JUDGING, SOMETIMES DEFINITELY DO IT!

"Judge not that you be not judged" (Mt. 7:1). That is talking about not nit-picking people apart, condemning about the speck in their eye, finding fault with them. However, for our protection and any people we are responsible for we are to definitely judge if a person is a dog or a swine or a ravenous wolf; if we do not they could despise the precious and tear us into pieces (Mt. 7:6,15). We will know them, judge them, by their fruits (Mt. 7:16). We are also definitely to judge/discern everything that comes toward us whether it is of God or not. We are able to do this by the anointing teaching us. We are to believe the anointing within's teaching, reject the bad, receive the good with the result and intent of abiding in Jesus (I Jn. 2:26-27). In summary, no nit-picky judging (diagnose not that you be not diagnosed). Judge for protection and for the purpose of you yourself abiding in Jesus.
