

## JESUS DID THE MAXIMUM

Jesus' assignment was to:

- 1) Come to earth in the likeness of sinful flesh (Rom. 8:3),
- 2) Live the most perfect life that can be lived, the sin free life (2 Cor. 5:21)
- 3) Show what God is like (Jn. 5:19, 14:9) and to teach what God and God's kingdom is like,
- 4) Endure the most that sin could direct against Him (in other ages, it could have taken on other outward forms, but spiritually it would just be another face of maximum evil) (Heb. 12:2-3),
- 5) Overcome sin's worst weapon (death), overcome the maximum foe by using the most overcoming power, the Spirit of Holiness (Rom. 1:4, Col. 2:15),
- 6) Be raised to the highest position, authority level possible (Eph. 1:19-23),
- 7) Pour out the Holy Spirit to us after the resurrection (Jn. 7:37-39).

Some results of Jesus' completed assignment:

Since Jesus was an "adam" (see the teaching "Jesus paid the price to hereditary-nature-ism), His seed, which is word of God seed, has inherent in it all this victory, overcoming power against evil, making right power, and resurrection life power, which is available to us by faith (Eph. 1:19, Gal. 3:13). This is so that we can by grace walk, led by the Spirit, and reign in life victorious (Rom. 5:17, 1 Jn. 5:4, 1 Pet. 2:23)
