

## JESUS PAID THE PRICE TO HEREDITARY-NATURE-ISM

For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's (1 Cor. 6:20). This teaching will explain what (not who) the price was paid to. The answer is hereditary-nature-ism. Jesus did the only thing that could be done in the only way possible to reverse and overcome sin and death that had entered the world and spread to all men as mentioned in Romans 5:12. More detailed explanation will follow.

First it needs to be understood what is meant by bearing something for someone. This will help us get better understanding of Jesus bearing our sins for us. Someone is in a situation where they need help. They of themselves cannot get out of it. You, by yourself, do a certain action that eradicates the problem so they no longer need help. Such a restoration for them has occurred that they can then go about doing good and helping others. Then you bore their problem. Note: your yourself do something. Their problem is eliminated. They are restored to the point where can help others. They are a fountain, not a drain. They are a source, not a sink.

Matthew 8:14-17 illustrates this concept. Many were healed and it was said that it fulfilled a passage in Isaiah that said He bore our bore our sickness. Note the account of Peter's mother-in-law being healed. See how Jesus bore her sickness. Note Jesus Himself did something; he touched her. The problem was eliminated; she was healed. She could now help others; she arose and served them.. Instead of having to be ministered to she was able to minister to others. This is a way to truly help people. God using you to help transform them from being a drain to being a fountain. What a glorious reversal. See how understanding of what it means to bear something for someone can open your eyes of a powerful way to help people. Pray for them to rise up to where they can help others!

Let's look at a second witness that our definition of "bear" is correct. Looking at Galatians 6:1-5 we see at first glance what seems like contradictory statements, "Bear one another's burdens and so fulfill the law of Christ" and "For each one shall bear his own load." But note the situation, someone overtaken in a trespass. At that time the overtaken one is not a source but a sink, not serving God. But those that are spiritual, meaning God works through them as a source, are to restore him. That means they are to do something that changes him from his

state on not serving God to where he can serve God. Once restored by having his burden borne by someone spiritual, he is then able to freely serve God and help others, which is bearing his own load as described in verse 5. Instead of you being a load for someone else, you bear your own load. Instead of the overtaken one being a load for someone else the overtaken one is transformed to be overcoming one and bears his own load. We were created to serve the Lord, to bear our load, our body part work in the kingdom of God.

The next step in getting understanding of what Jesus paid the price to is to get understanding of first Adam and Last Adam. First Adam was the first created man and was given the name Adam. Genesis 2 and 3 tell of first Adam and his sin. In 1 Cor. 15:45 it talks about first Adam and last Adam....Jesus is last Adam. Jesus was an Adam that did it right! So just what is an Adam? An Adam is a very special type of person that all he is, was, succeeded at, failed at, becomes part of the very nature of those born of an Adam. For the first Adam, since he sinned, everyone born of first Adam inherited as part of their very nature sin and what comes along with sin is death. Hence we have a sin nature that we are born with that we of ourselves cannot rid ourselves of and should Jesus tarry in his return, we will all die a physical death. That was inherited through Adam. Romans 5:12 points out through one man (first Adam) sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned. Romans 6:23 points out that the wages of sin is death. That is the mess all humans are in that are born of first Adam. The evil one thought he had captured the system of heredity to irreversibly spread his evil work of sin and death. Surprise evil one there is last Adam, Jesus.

In Luke 1:35 it is seen that Jesus was born of a virgin; the fathering seed was supplied by the Holy Spirit. So Jesus was not born of Adam, so Jesus, last Adam, had no inherent sin nature. So Jesus was in the likeness of sinful flesh (Rom. 8:3) but not sinful flesh since Jesus, last Adam, was not born of first Adam seed. Since the seed that Jesus came from was the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit is from above, Jesus could say He was from above (Jn. 8:23). Jesus lived a sinless life, unlike first Adam. It says in 2 Cor. 5:21 that Jesus knew no sin. In Hebrews 4:15 it says that Jesus, last Adam, was tempted in all points like we are, yet without sin. Jesus offered Himself up as a sacrifice for sin (John 10:18) on the cross. This made Jesus a curse (Gal. 3:13), made him sin who knew not sin (2 Cor. 5:21). Jesus rose in victory from death, Hades and

the grave (Acts 2:27) and was seated at the right hand of the Father and given the name above all names (Eph. 1:20-21) and poured out the Holy Spirit to us (Acts 2:33). That is GOOD NEWS since all that happened to an Adam. Hence, all born of last Adam, Jesus, inherently receive victory over sin by inheriting a righteous nature from the new birth. In 2 Cor. 5:21, it says that He made Him (Jesus) who knew no sin for us, that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him. We are made righteous by inheritance, by being born of last Adam, Jesus.

So how can anyone like us here on this planet now who has been born of first Adam, be born of last Adam, Jesus, and be made righteous, start all over, have our sins purged, be as white as snow in God's sight and live for God. Answer: you must be born again (Jn. 3:3)

First Adam's seed, the way he produced descendants was through physical seed. That is the way you have babies! To be born of Jesus, the last Adam, it is through spiritual word of God Jesus seed. It turns out that the word of God is seed (Lk. 8:11) and you get born again by believing the word of God seed about Jesus. In 1 Peter 1:23 it says we have been born again by the incorruptible seed of the word of God. You hear that word of God seed that tells of Jesus being born of a virgin, fathered by the Holy Spirit, living a sinless life, being crucified to bear our sins, being raised from the dead and seated at the right hand of the Father. You believe that in your heart to the point of confessing it that Jesus is Lord and you are saved (Romans 8:9-10). You are to be baptized (immersed in water) in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit to be united with his death and be raised to walk in newness of life (Rom. 6:4-5). All this is called being made right (justified, righteousified) by faith. It is not based on any goodness in you because without Jesus you have an inherit sin nature. It is not based on any good works that you do, because nothing you can do of self can reverse your inherent sin nature. Jesus had to do what He did for us to help us when we could not help ourselves. That is what it means that Jesus bore our sin. Jesus came and did what He did as last Adam so His seed when believed would restore us to the state we were supposed to be in as if first Adam had not sinned. In 1 Peter 2:24 it says that Jesus bore our sins in His own body on the tree (the cross) that we having died to sins might live for righteousness---by whose stripes we were healed!

So Jesus paid the price to the system that says an Adam passes on His traits spiritually and physically to those born of that Adam. All Jesus did is what it took for us to have our sins purged, our deep core spiritual

nature be a righteous nature and not a sin nature, so we could be unleashed to start over, to live for righteousness, serving the living God, not burdened, our face in the wind!

That may be a lot to take in. However, you do not need to know how to repair everything in a car to drive it. The important thing is that God so loved the world that he gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in His should not perish, but have everlasting life (Jn. 3:16). Who Himself (Jesus) bore our sins in His own body on the tree that we having died to sins might live for righteousness...by whose stripes, we were healed (1 Peter 2:24)!

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
