

## PURR-MAH-NAY-SAY

He who abides in Me and I in Him bears much fruit. (in John 15:5) I saw in a Spanish translation of this verse that the Spanish word used for "abides" is "permanece" (roughly pronounced PURR-MAH-NAY-SAY). Looks a whole lot like the word PERMANENT. So he who PERMANENTLY is in Jesus and Jesus is PERMANENTLY in him bears much fruit. This nails it. A Christian is not to be a spiritual yoyo but PERMANENTLY Christian. Permanently seek, think, listen for, and do God's will. Not mind of the Spirit sometimes and swamp mind others. Wonderful fruit will happen to you and come from you. This ends NAY-SAYing.
